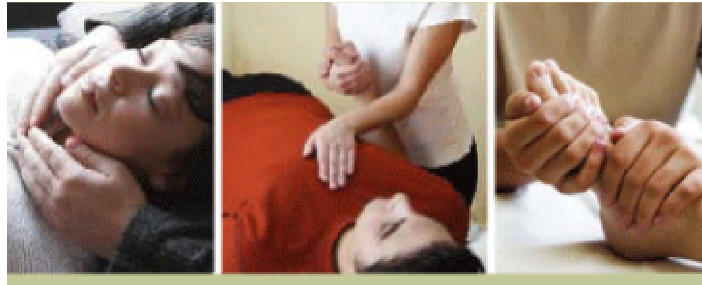


What is a Healing Touch Practitioner Apprentice?

Healing Touch practitioners integrate and practice Healing Touch within the scope of their education, training, current licensing and credentialing.

A **Healing Touch International Practitioner APPRENTICE** has completed Level 4 coursework (taught by a Certified Healing Touch Instructor) and is participating in a minimum one-year mentorship process with a Certified Healing Touch Practitioner. During the one-year mentorship, the apprentice is required to complete and document 100 hours of healing touch client sessions.

Healing Touch is a relaxing, nurturing energy therapy. Gentle touch assists in balancing the individual's physical, mental, emotional and spiritual well-being.
